


4. Fees







6. After the selection.

After the selection, please complete the following steps

Pay the program fees to the Meiji SPSE account by CREDIT CARD within the designated payment period in Mid-April 2024. [NOTE] *Please be ready to pay with your own credit card by the beginning of April. If it is difficult to make a payment with your own credit card, please contact us via your administrative staff at your home university.
Plan and arrange your own itinerary to attend the program and purchase your own flight tickets. [NOTE] *You must arrive at Tokyo by June 23 by your own choice of itinerary. *Check-in date: June 23, 2024 *Check-out date: July 12, 2024
(1) Buy travel insurance as instructed in "Appendix ". The insurance should cover the whole period of the program including the date of your departure and of your return to your home country.(2) Submit a scanned copy of your insurance certificate to the Meiji SPSE Office.
Apply for your visa as instructed by the administrative staff at your university. An invitation letter will be issued by the Meiji SPSE office in April. * See Appendix 2: Visa considerations for details.


7. Certificate of Completion

A "Certificate of Completion" will be issued when you complete whole program.

The required participation level is 85% or above.

8. Cancellation Policy

Once your application has been made, the cancellation policy below will apply to the program fees to Meiji University. Notify the SPSE Office of your cancellation/withdrawal with a Cancellation Form by the deadline (TBA in the Notification of Acceptance). After the deadline, you will be required to pay the full program fees even if you cancel your participation.



[NOTES]

- The cancellation policy above will be applied regardless of the reasons for cancellation.
- The SPSE Office will provide the Cancellation Form after the home university notifies the SPSE Office of a possible cancellation.

All participants in this program are required to purchase overseas travel insurance, including medical insurance. Please purchase insurance offered by a major travel insurance company before your departure and send a copy of your insurance certificate to the SPSE office at Meiji University by May, 2024.

Ensure that your insurance covers not only the program period but also the day of your departure from your country and the day of your return to your country.

Your insurance policy should include the following medical coverage:

a) Medical benefits (accident and illness)



Please review the visa policy on the website of the immigration bureau or foreign affairs bureau of your country.

Invitation Letters for students will be sent from the SPSE office to the administrative staff of each partner university. Please receive it when you are contacted by the administrative staff at your home university and apply for your visa. The student or the partner school should prepare other documents required for the application.

■ For participants from partner schools in Bangkok, Thailand:

The SPSE office will send the original letters of invitation to Meiji University's ASEAN Center (MAC) in Bangkok. MAC will inform each partner university when the letters are ready for pick-up. Please make sure to receive the documents there. After receiving the letters, apply for a visa with other necessary documents. Other documents should be prepared by students or partner universities.


